Twin tribal murders: Govt announces Rs 4-lakh compensation

STATE MINISTER of Education and Tribal Development Kuber Dindor on Saturday visited the families of two tribal men killed after being assaulted on their suspicion at an under-construction tribal museum near the Statue of Unity (SoJ) three days ago in Narmada district's Garudeshwar and announced a compensation of Rs 4 lakh each for the nine victims. Six workers of the agency con-

structing the tribal museum have been arrested in connection with the case so far.

Earlier, the contracting agency had also announced Rs 20 lakh compensation for victims Jayesh Tadv and Sanjay Tadv.

Dindor, accompanied by Bharuch MP Manoj Vasava and Nandod MLA Darshana Deshmukh also assured the families of 'complete justice'.

with the police since the incident, seeking the contracting agency to be made an accused in the FIR, Dindor said. "Some (political) people are trying to politicise the issue for their vested interests."

The Dediapada MLA had on Friday called for a bandh in Gandeshwar to protest the twin murders.

Dindor said, "The issue came concluded at this point as the police are working on the investigation and the compensation has been announced. We have taken

legal recourse and completed the procedure of putting the accused behind bars and they will be punished by the court."

"These people (opposition) know that they cannot do anything actually (in procedure) because it is the government that will do what has to be done... they are idle, so they are following their customary practice of misleading people in their gains."

Bharuch MP Vasava said, "The government is with the families and they will be extended help as they need it. The contracting

agency has also given the families Rs 20 lakh because the government intervened in the matter but the opposition and many other elements in Gujarat, especially the AAP Dediapada MLA, are trying their best to defeat the government in the matter."

"No one supports such incidents and the provisions of the law have been studied in depth to ensure that the accused will be brought to the book so that it becomes a deterrent by law."

Meanwhile, MLA Chaitar Vasava urged the residents of the

tribal belt to join in a protest on August 13, when the families of the deceased have organised a prayer meeting. The MLA has also demanded a compensation of Rs 1 crore for the families. "The atrocities against the tribal men is an other example of the resentment that (the BJP) has for the tribals; it is our land, our people, our natural wealth in this region and outsiders assault and kill our people; we will not let this happen," he said.

"Is the value of the life of a tribal Rs 4 or 5 lakh? We have demanded a compensation of Rs 1

core for the families, who have lost their sole breadwinners for life," he added.

On Friday, the Gandeshwar police took the six accused to the crime scene—the tribal museum near Eka Nagar—where they had allegedly killed the two men in their 30s to a cabin on August 6 night before assaulting them with pipes and iron rods.

Strict action against govt teachers taking salary without working: Dindor

THE GOVERNMENT school teachers drawing salaries without reporting to work will face disciplinary action along with the officials responsible for recording attendance, said Gujarat Minister of Education and Tribal Development Kuber Dindor on Saturday.

The development comes after the Gujarat government ordered a probe against a government school teacher who allegedly continues to be on the payroll despite settling in the US and remaining absent from duty for nearly eight years. Dindor was in Chitroda Uddepur district to attend the 75th Van Mahotsav.

Dindor, who attended the forest department event at the Punimavati Ekikayam Model School in Chitroda Uddepur said, "The matter concerning one teacher has come to light and we have decided to initiate a proactive drive into the matter; the fact

that one teacher was abroad and drawing a salary is a serious matter but the person, who has marked this teacher's attendance at a bigger fault."

Dindor said, "We will initiate action against the teacher and also the person, who has marked attendance for this teacher. I have sought a report from 32,000 schools in the district to come... if any teacher is found drawing salaries while not reporting to work or being abroad, strict disciplinary action will be initiated against the teacher as well as the official marking the attendance and they will all be sent packing."

Goyal announces restoration of Diamond Imprest Licence for gems, jewellery sector

UNION MINISTER of Commerce & Industry Piyush Goyal on Saturday announced the restoration of Diamond Imprest Licence in an interactive session at the 40th edition of India International Jewellery Show (IJS), the flagship show of the Gem & Jewellery Export Promotion Council (GJPEC) held in Mumbai.

The GJPEC had been seeking the restoration of the licence, which allows import duty exemption on cut and polished diamonds up to a specified limit.

In the absence of this licence, the cut and polished diamonds were getting imported in Dubai and getting assorted there and re-exported, impacting India's exports and jobs in the sector.

"This will provide level-playing field for Indian MSME diamond exporters, will stop flight of investment and also introduce more employment opportunities," said a GJPEC member.

The licence allows eligible exporters to import cut and polished diamonds, including rough, processed, half-cut, and broken diamonds.

Exporters can import diamonds up to 5 per cent of their average turnover from the past three years, with a requirement to add 10 per cent value.

These imports must be used by the importer and cannot be transferred, even after exports are completed, according to an expert. Explaining the changes in the licence, GTRI founder Ajay Srivastava said that some countries like South Africa, Namibia and Tanzania require rough diamonds to be cut or processed before export.

HARNI BOAT CAPSIZES Showcause notices sent to two former municipal commissioners, HC told

THE GOVERNMENT on Friday informed the Gujarat High Court that it has issued showcause notices to two erstwhile municipal commissioners of Vadodra—Vinod Rao and H S Patel—in connection with the redevelopment of Harni Lake, where a boat capsized on January 18, killing 12 students and two teachers on a picnic.

The division bench of Chief Justice Sanjay Agarwal and Justice Pranav Trivedi is hearing the suo motu plea in the case.

Advocate General Kamal Trivedi informed the court that the notices were issued on July 19 based on HCS's July 9 order directing the state government that the "disciplinary action" initiated on the basis of a fact-finding report, "shall be brought to its logical conclusion... and the result shall be brought before court."

Trivedi also informed the court that Rao had challenged the high court order in the Supreme Court.

The advocates appearing for the families of boat tragedy victims informed the court that the notices issued to M/s Kota Projects and the New Sunrise School on July 12, seeking them to be respondents in the case for "exemplary compensation" that be awarded to the victims, have gone "unused" as no entity was present at the registered addresses to accept the notices.

The court directed that a fresh notice be issued to both parties—Kota Projects and the school and directed the Vadodra District Collector and police to ensure that the notices are served.

The fact-finding committee had stated that the entire process of granting contract to Kota Projects in second attempt after they failed to qualify in first attempt, and the commissioner endorsing what is put before him by technical team, is generally followed at Vadodra Municipal Corporation as also similar to what is followed in other urban local bodies and, therefore, no fault can be found in the process. The next hearing into the case is on August 30.

Sardar Sarovar dam 80% full with steady inflow from Madhya Pradesh

THE SARDAR Sarovar dam (SSP) in Narmada on Saturday recorded a level of 133.46 meters, rising by over six meters in a span of two days due to the inflow of about 4.8 billion cubic metres of water from Madhya Pradesh, said the officials even as the Vadodra district administration has alerted the villages located along Narmada riverbank.

According to the Sardar Sarovar Narmada Nigam officials (SSNN), officials, once the level crosses the 134-meter mark, the authorities will decide on opening the dam's radial gates for a safe filling up to the Full Reservoir Level (FRL) of 136.68 metres.

At 133.46 meters Saturday evening, the dam was 80% full with a gross storage of 7,525 million cubic metres (MCM) and 3,825 MCM is the live storage of the dam. SSNN officials said that the inflow from Indragar and Omkareshwar dams in Madhya Pradesh was recorded at 4.8 lakh cuses while the discharge from

Officials said that to maintain a "cushion level" in the dam for any unforeseen inflow of water, the RBPH will continue to generate power and release about 44,000 cuses of water — the amount of water released after a full cycle of operating six Francis-type reversible turbine generators of RBPH with a capacity of 200 MW each.

"Since the average inflow during the day is currently high, we are continuing to release the water directly downstream through the operation of RBPH. Beyond 134 meters we will have to maintain a cushion level to allow the dam to rise up to FRL in a balanced way and there is a possibility of opening a few radial gates once the dam crosses the level of 134 meters," an official added.

Meanwhile, the Vadodra district administration alerted 36 villages located along Narmada riverbank. The Narmada district administration has also alerted 25 villages along the river and a helicopter number 1077 has been activated for the flood situation.

The Sardar Sarovar dam on Saturday recorded a level of 133.46 m, rising by over 6 m in two days. Express

Narmada Dam was at 55760 cuses after generation of power in the Riverbed Power House (RBPH) and the Canal Head Powerhouse.

Marked rise in the dam level has been recorded since August 1, when it stood at 122.17 metres. Thereafter, since Tuesday (August 6), the dam began receiving water from Indragar in Madhya Pradesh and its level steadily increased to 126.44 metres on August 7. However, in last 72
